Mail-in Ballot packages will be sent by July 7th, to all eligible electors, to their last known address of record with the Nation. Mail-in ballots must be received must by the Electoral Officer no later than 8 p.m. on August 6, 2026. Even though you receive a mail-in ballot package, you may choose to vote by mail, online or in-person. Please ensure that your address is up to date for the purpose of receiving a mail-in ballot package. You may contact the Electoral Officer to update your address.

Online Voting: To vote electronically, visit the One Feather link below. When you get to the website you will be prompted through the process to cast your vote. **Online voting begins at 9:00 AM on July 23, 2026 and ends at 8:00 PM on August 6, 2026.**
